

Kimberley Riverside Campground - Covid19 Swimming Pool Policy June 13, 2021

Occupancy

- Maximum occupancy in the fenced area is 30 persons at anytime, and everyone must maintain 2-meter social distance between non-household groups. Spectators are included in the 30-person limit so please limit the number of additional spectators, when possible, to ensure more people have the opportunity to swim.

Booking info

- Use of the swimming pool is by appointment and is for a 1.5-hour period.
- You can make your appointment in the office at 10am on the day which you would like to swim. You cannot book any days in advance. Please come to the office at 10am to schedule your appointment as bookings will NOT be accepted over the phone.
- Only people registered to a campsite are permitted to swim. If you have friends or family visiting that are not registered here at the campground they are not permitted in the pool. Extra charges or additional site registrations will apply.
- The pool is open daily from 10am to 9pm, and the appointment sessions are: 10:00am to 11:30am / 11:40am to 1:10pm / 1:20pm to 2:50pm / 3:00pm to 4:30pm / 4:40pm to 6:10pm / 6:20pm to 7:50pm
- When you arrive/depart for your swim appointment you will need to register your arrival at the office and will receive a laminated card. When you depart the pool, you need to return your laminated card to the office.
- Arrivals will have a 15-minute grace period. If you are 15+ minutes late for your pool appointment, it will be considered a no show and will be offered to people wanting to extend or someone “walking in” without a swimming appointment.
- You cannot pre-book more than one appointment in a day. We do allow you to swim more than once on the basis that there are vacancies at other sessions for you to “walk in” without an appointment. We will not know this until that next appointment session has started.

General Pool Info

- We suggest coming to the pool in your swimsuit to maximize your swimming time as changing/showering will be part of your 1.5-hour allowance. This would also eliminate crowding in the washrooms.
- Pool Furniture will not be provided and customers will have the option to bring their own lawn chair. Please note the perimeter wood bench will not be sanitized.
- The Chess pieces will be available for use with hand sanitizer provided nearby.
- All customers must follow the pool’s posted signage and are required to follow the COVID policies (as set out in the waiver signed upon arrival and this document). Our Pool rules also include the following:
 - NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY
 - All patrons must take a full shower before entering the swimming pool
 - No food, drinking or smoking on the pool deck or area. Only plastic water bottles are permitted.
 - No swimming under the influence of drugs or alcohol
 - No diving, running, fighting or engaging in an activity which may cause an injury or disturbance to yourself or other pool users.
 - Children under 14 must be supervised by an adult
 - Do not enter the pool with an illness including open sores, wounds, bandages, head colds or any symptoms associated with Covid19.
 - Notify a staff member of any injury, contamination or fouling of the swimming pool.

Anyone that ignores the registration process, fails to maintain the required social distance of 2 meters or purposely ignores the occupancy limit will be banned from the swimming pool.
