

Kimberley Riverside Campground - Covid19 Swimming Pool Policy 2 – Revised July 4th

Occupancy

- Maximum occupancy in the fenced area is 30 persons at anytime, and everyone must maintain 2-meter social distance between non-household groups.

Booking info

- Use of the swimming pool is by appointment and is for a 1.5-hour period, with the exception of 8pm (which is only a 1-hour booking).
- You can make your appointment from 10am on the day which you would like to swim. You cannot book any days in advance. Please come to the office at 10am when possible to schedule your appointment as phone lines can be busy. Emails/Voice messages will not take priority over a person booking at the office.
- The pool is open daily from 10am to 9pm, and the appointment times available are: 10:00am to 11:30am / 11:40am to 1:10pm / 1:20pm to 2:50pm / 3:00pm to 4:30pm / 4:40pm to 6:10pm / 6:20pm to 7:50pm / 8:00pm to 9:00pm
- Arrivals will have a 15-minute grace period. If you are 15+ minutes late for your pool appointment, it will be considered a no show and may be offered to a “walk-in” pool customer.
- You cannot book more than one appointment in a day. The only exception is if you are a “walk-in” pool customer and there are still vacant spaces in that timeframe. You can “walk in” multiple times in the day if vacancy is available. If the timeframe is already fully booked with 30 people, you will not be able to go in.

General Pool Info

- We suggest coming to the pool in your swimsuit to maximize your swimming time as changing/showering will be part of your 1.5-hour allowance. This would also eliminate crowding in the washrooms.
- Pool Furniture will not be provided and customers will have the option to bring their own lawn chair. Please note the perimeter wood bench will not be sanitized.
- The Chess pieces will be available for use with hand sanitizer provided nearby, and chess pieces will be sanitized at 12pm, 4pm and 6pm. Please use the provided hand sanitizer before and after use. The table tennis equipment is signed out from the office and is sanitized after each rental.
- All customers must follow the pool’s posted signage and are required to follow the COVID policies (as set out in the waiver signed upon arrival and this document). Our Pool rules also include the following:
 - NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY
 - All patrons must take a full shower before entering the swimming pool
 - No food, drinking or smoking on the pool deck or area. Only plastic water bottles are permitted.
 - No swimming under the influence of drugs or alcohol
 - No diving, running, fighting or engaging in an activity which may cause an injury or disturbance to yourself or other pool users.
 - Children under 14 must be supervised by an adult
 - Do not enter the pool with an illness including open sores, wounds, bandages, head colds or any symptoms associated with Covid19.
 - Notify a staff member of any injury, contamination or fouling of the swimming pool.

Anyone that ignores the registration process, fails to maintain the required social distance of 2 meters or purposely ignores the occupancy limit will be banned from the swimming pool.
